DOG FRIENDLY LOCATIONS

STATE FOREST

The Oberon region is surrounded by many acres of State Forest which is open for recreational activities such as bushwalking with your canine friend. Forests include Vulcan State Forest, Hampton State Forest, Blenheim State Forest, Essington State Forest, Dog Rocks State Forest, Jenolan State Forest, Lowes Mount State Forest. Many State Forests in our LGA are adjacent to private land, where dogs are prohibited, so make sure you stay within State Forest while visiting with your dog.

MAYFIELD GARDEN

A spectacular 65 hectares of cool climate garden for you to wander at your leisure. Open daily 9am-4.30pm with Mayfield Garden Cafe. You must keep your dog on a lead at all times and please clean up after them.

OBERON DAM TRACKS

Access via Links Close or Jenolan Street. Zig Zag your way through native gum forest bush tracks. Views of Lake Oberon.

PIONEER HERITAGE RAIL TRAIL

6km/12km return of sealed path from Oberon Tarana Heritage Railway to Hazelgrove Siding.

OBERON COMMON

Situated opposite Oberon Visitor Information Centre, skate park, public art, undercover picnic tables and bbqs.

OBERON OFF-LEASH DOG PARK

Dogs are required to be restrained while in a public place with the exception of prescribed dog exercise areas. Find Oberon fenced off-leash Dog Park at the bottom of Jenolan Street (on the left before the Oberon Dam gates)
